**DIRECTIONS TO THREE LAKES SKI TRAIL:**

Coming off Highway 53, take exit number 110, which is the Highway 40 exit, into Bloomer. When you reach the bridge just past the high school, take a right onto Main Street. Travel two (2) blocks and turn left onto 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue. When you reach the stop sign, turn right onto Martin Rd. This is also County Highway SS. Stay on SS until you reach 110<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right onto 110<sup>th</sup> street and then take a left onto 165<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The Three Lakes Ski Trail will be on the right just after you go over the first hill. **Bus Parking will be available in the field. Spectator parking on the road (165th Avenue).**
