Entry Fee: \$100 high school; \$80 middle school - Checks payable to Prescott School District

Awards: Middle School - Top 3 middle school athletes will receive medals. Ribbons for 4th - 10th.

Awards will be given to athletes at the finish line. No middle school award ceremony.

High School - Top 10 girls and top 10 boys in the high school races will receive medals.

Team placings will be announced, but there will be no team awards.

Spectator Parking: Please park in the main (front) high school parking lot. The lot behind the school is reserved for handicapped parking and race officials.
