Hilbert MS Invite Saturday May 4th, 2024

- Place:** Hilbert High School Track – 1139 W. Milwaukee St.
- Schools:** Brillion, Chilton, Hilbert, Kiel, Mishicot, New Holstein, Reedsville, Roncalli, St. Mary Catholic, & Two Rivers
- Facilities:** Eight lane 400 meter rubberized track and jumping surfaces.
Only 1/8 inch pyramid spikes allowed
Shot and Discus circles are both concrete.
- Buses:** Please park behind the school by the track
- Admission:** Adults - \$3.00 Students - \$2.00
- Locker Rooms:** There will be no locker rooms available. Restrooms will be available and will be located by the concession stand and the field events.
- Bullpen:** The bullpen will be located at the start line for the 110 hurdles. All participants must report to the Clerk of Course in this area, including all members of relay teams.
- Camps:** All team camps must be set up on the west side of the track by the fence.
- Restricted Areas:** Only athletes in a current event are allowed on the infield. All coaches and spectators are **NOT** allowed in this area.
- Concessions:** Available throughout the meet.
- Awards:** Team plaques will be awarded to the boys and girls champion. Medals will be awarded for individual 1st place finishes. Ribbons will be awarded for 2nd through 6th places.
- Scoring:** Team scoring will consist of 8 places (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1) in all events.
- Entry Fee:** \$75 – Please try to mail before the meet.
- Entries:** A school may enter up to 3 athletes per event and 1 team per relay with a maximum of 33 individual entries. Please remember that being listed as an alternate counts as an event for that individual.

Entry Forms: Entries will be accepted on-line only. We will be using *Prime Time Timing* for On-line entries. Log on to www.pttiming to submit entries. You must have your entries submitted by:

Thursday, May 2nd @ Noon

There will be a **\$200** fine for late entries.

Heat sheets will be available at Prime Time Timings website.

Timing: The meet itself will be hand timed.

Changes: Scratches will be allowed the day of the meet but replacements will only be allowed with a physician's note. In the case of a scratch or a replacement, we will not re-seed the event. .

Running Events: In the trials (100 hurdles and 100 dashes) the 1st place winners of each heat and the next fastest times from all the heats will make the finals. For races run in sections, the slowest section will be run first.

Field Events: Open pits will be in place for long & triple jump with each athlete receiving 4 total jumps. The long and triple jumps will be open from 10:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. Girls shot and boys disc will each go first with each athlete receiving 4 total throws. Girls high jump will go first. As per WIAA rule, there will be **no tape allowed on the runways**.
