Times:

- Implement weigh-in will be by the press box and must be done no later than **3:45**
- Coaches meet **4:00** near the timing tent. No substitutions or additions, only scratches.
- Field events will begin at **3:45**. Athletes must check-in prior to the start of competition.
 - Girls shot put, followed by boys
 - Boys' discus, followed by girls
 - Girls high jump, followed by boys (starting heights will be determined by WIAA rules)
 - Boys pole vault, followed by girls (starting heights will be determined by WIAA rules)
 - Boys and girls long jump will be cafeteria style
 - Boys and girls triple jump will be cafeteria style
- Running events will begin at **4:15** and follow the WIAA tournament order of events (on following page).
 - All runners must check in with the clerk at the south end of the track, behind the 100m start.

Entries:

- Teams are limited to 28 boys and 28 girls individual entries, with no more than 3 per event, and one relay team per relay event.
- Entries must be submitted online via <https://pttiming.com/event.php?mid=2252&pt=schedule>
 - Entries open May 11th.
 - **Entries are due by noon on Sunday, May 18**
- Each participant will be allowed 3 attempts per field event. Shot put, discus, long jump, and triple jump will conduct finals of the top 9 competitors (3 additional attempts).

Other Meet Information:

- All WIAA uniform rules will be enforced.
- Athletes excused from a field event will have 15 minutes from the time their name is called to return for their next trial. They must check-out with the event judge before leaving.
- Reminder: pole vault weigh-in forms must be dated no earlier than **May 18**.
- Running and jumping surfaces are rubberized. Athletes may wear ¼" pyramid spikes only.
- Coaches will be asked to assist with exchange zones for the 4x100m and 4x200m relays.
- Scoring will be 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 for both individuals and relays. Team trophies and medals for top 2 finishers will be awarded. Individual schools will need to print their own certificates for places 1-3.
- Entry fee of **\$325** may be mailed or brought on the day of the meet.
- Please set up tents in the grassy areas outside the track (along the East side).
 - Athletes are asked to stay out of the infield if they are not preparing for competition.
- Concessions will be available.
- Restrooms will be available, but water fountains may not be available, so athletes should bring water.
