Entries:

- Each school is limited to **three (3)** individuals per event.
- Each school is limited to **one (1)** per relay event
- Entries will be done online through **PT Timing.**

- Entries will close at NOON, Sunday, April 27, 2025
- After the close of entries there will be no additions—scratches or substitutions only.
 - Scratches MUST be made at the finish line at 3:30.

Facilities:

- The track is a 400-meter seal-flex surface.
- There are 8 lanes on the straightaway and 6 lanes around the curve.
 - o 1/4" pyramid spikes are permitted.
 - Shot and discus areas are concrete. FLATS ONLY!!

Please Note:

- The infield area will be closed to all except for meet officials and competitors (as appropriate).
 - o Team tent/meeting areas must be outside of the track.
- Buses should turn at Kwik Trip and continue on to Tainter Street to the track. Buses must arrive before 3:10 PM or after 3:25 PM to prevent congestion with after school buses.
