ENTRIES

Enter runners at www.pttiming.com by 11:59pm on Tuesday, October 21. Scroll to find your sectional site (Manitowoc Lincoln). Please note that Manitowoc Lutheran is also hosting a sectional meet. Any school who misses the entry deadline may still be allowed to enter but their WIAA reimbursement will be withheld if their team or individual(s) qualify for state. Teams may make changes to their roster up until race time. A school may make changes to its team makeup from Sectional to State Competition.

LANE ASSIGNMENTS will be assigned by WIAA and provided prior to race day.

MEET OFFICIALS: will be assigned by the WIAA.

JURY OF APPEALS: Will consist of the starter, meet manager Michael Bubolz, Boys head coach Oshkosh West, Girls head coach-Sheboygan South, and Boys head coach- Fond Du Lac

COACHES: Please refer to the WIAA Cross Country Sectional/State Tournament information at the WIAA website for further information regarding the tournament procedures and State Meet qualifiers.

Concessions: There will be a concession stand located near the clubhouse.

Long Sleeve Sectional Shirts will be sold for \$25 and can be found near the concession stand.

Directions to Meadow Links: I-43 to exit 154 – (Hwy 310) go east and follow to Johnston Drive. Turn right on Johnston Drive.

BUS PARKING: Buses and spectators may park on Johnston Drive or surrounding neighborhood streets.

TEAM TENT: Team tent area is along Johnston Dr between the street and the running course. Please do not set up within 10 ft. of Johnston Drive.

Aurora/BayCare Sports Medicine Athletic Trainer will be on site at 9:30 am. The trainer will not be available to treat pre-existing injuries such as taping, etc.

BIBS: Upon arrival, please pick up bibs and any additional meet information at the finish line.

RESTRICTED AREAS:

The flagged/roped off area around the finish line, the area immediately around the PT Timing van, the starting line, the bowling alley/clubhouse, and the awards balcony. These areas are only for appropriate competing athletes and meet personnel.

AWARDS PRESENTATION will take place as soon as possible after the D3 girls' race is completed. This will occur in the west parking lot/balcony area. D1 awards will be first and D3 to follow. We will recognize all State Meet qualifiers- the two top team finishers and the top five individuals not on those qualifying teams. Results will be posted at the meet and each school will receive a copy of the meet results at www.pttiming.com.

STATE MEET PARKING PASS AND INFORMATION

The WIAA will send an email to schools with qualifiers providing a State Meet Parking Pass/Sign for the top two teams in both the boys' and girls' races, as well as for the top five individual finishers that are not members of a qualifying team. The information will be sent out on Monday following Sectionals and prior to the State Tournament
