The track is an eight lane, rubberized track. 1/4" spikes will be allowed for all events. Starting blocks will be provided.

Entries/Runners

We will be using **PT Timing**. To register or enter your teams, go to ([www.pt timing.com](http://www.pttiming.com)). You may need to create a "new account" with a username and password that can be used all season for any meet timed by **PT Timing**. Once you login you will need to enter your roster. Do not include athletes you know will not be able to run. If in doubt, enter them. After your roster is entered you will specify which race each athlete will compete in. **Registration opens on Tuesday,**

## Special Note

- Maximum of four events per athlete.
- Maximum of three running events or three field events per athlete.
- No more than five participants per school per event.
- There will be no pole vault.
- Depending on the number of entries, the girls and boys may run the 3200 Relay and 3200 Run together.

## Meet Info

1. Coaches will be provided with lanyards to be authorized on the infield. All other spectators/parents will not be permitted. Please turn the lanyard in at the concession stand and receive a treat of your choice.
2. Lane assignments for all races of 400 m. or less will be 4-5-3-6-2-7-1-8
3. All athletes in the first round of field events should **check in** with the recorder by **3:45**, field event competition starts at 4:00 pm
4. A competitor in the field events who is excused to compete in another event shall have a maximum of **15 minutes** before his/her throw/jump. Make sure he/she is excused before leaving.
5. Scoring 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1
6. Please have runners report to the **Bullpen on the 2<sup>nd</sup> call.**
7. All times will be FAT.
8. There will not be trials for the running events. Everything will be finals with the fast heat last.
9. High Jump will be determined at the coaches meeting.
10. Shot Put & Discus throws will be done in flights – 4 throws total. Throwers must retrieve their own shot or disc.
11. Long Jump and Triple Jump will be done cafeteria style – 4 jumps total. (Runners are allowed to Piggy Back)
12. Do not use athletic tape on the track. Only use chalk.
13. Bus parking will be in the student parking lot or behind the football field on the hill.
