Track is a rubberized track with 6 lanes. 1/8" spikes will be allowed for all events.

Entries

We will be using PT Timing for timing and scoring of the meet. To register or enter your teams, go to www.pttiming.com. You may need to create an account with a username and password that can be used for all meets that use PT Timing. After login, please enter your roster. Do not include athletes that you know will not be able to compete. **Registration will open Wednesday, May 11 at noon and will close Wednesday, May 18 at 11:59am.** Schools that fail to meet the deadline will be subject to a \$50 late fee. Max Events

- Maximum of four events per person – no more than three running or three field events
- Each school can sign up for two teams for each relay
- Maximum of four entries per team in all non-relay events
- There will be no pole vault



Meet Information

1. A competitor in the field events who is excused to compete in another event shall have a maximum of 15 minutes before throw/jump. Make sure he/she is excused before leaving.
2. Substitutions may be made the day of the meet. You can drop or change a competitor (no reseed), but you cannot add.
3. Please have runners report to the bullpen on the 2nd call and remain there.
4. There will not be trials for the running events. Everything will be finals.
5. High Jump starting height will be determined at the Coaches Meeting.
6. Shot Put and Discus will be done in flights – 4 throws total. Throwers must retrieve their own shot or disc.
7. Long Jump and Triple Jump will be done cafeteria style – 4 jumps total.
8. Results will be available shortly after the meet and will be emailed to each school's AD.
9. Concessions will be available.
10. Restrooms will be available in the Fitness Center Locker Rooms
11. Team Awards for 1st and 2nd place; Individual Medals for 1st-3rd places. Depending on time, individual awards may be mailed after the meet.
12. Please drop your participants off at the HS track and park in the dirt parking lot, by the track, until 3:30. At 3:30 please move the busses to the Elementary School. Thank you in advance for working with us and our construction at the High School.
